Choosing a Confirmation Name

- The Christian name you select will be the name that the Bishop uses when you are anointed during the Sacrament of Confirmation
- When choosing the name of a saint or a name from sacred scripture, pay close attention to this person's Christian story, their virtues, and special graces given to them by God.
- In the Roman Catholic Church, the title "Venerable" is bestowed on a deceased person in the first of three stages leading to beatification. Once they are beatified, they receive the title of "Blessed" and when canonized, the title of "Saint".
