Recently the fifth graders had a STEM challenge to build the tallest tower they could using only 20 pencils and 20 clothespins. In pairs, they first planned out how they were going to build their towers. There was lots of good collaborative thinking going on! Then, it was time to build, and very soon into the process, they all discovered that they needed to make a strong base first or else their towers would topple. Some groups were more successful than others, but they all understood that with STEM activities, it's all about figuring out how to improve something when it doesn't work immediately. After the activity was finished, they reflected on their successes and challenges with the towers and they all agreed that they want to try this STEM activity again so they can use what they know from this time to build taller, stronger towers.
