This week, 4<sup>th</sup> grade made more than 100 origami butterflies! The butterflies are part of this month's service project and will go into Valentine's Day gift bags that will be distributed to local nursing homes. This project isn't just an act of service; it is also a learning experience. The class learned about the history of origami and its surprising origins in China (not Japan)! In addition, paper folding provides conceptual knowledge about lines of symmetry which is essential for understanding concepts of geometry. Of course, it was a lot of fun as well!



Recently, there have been multiple concerns regarding dropoff/pick-up. Please review the following reminders:

- If you are walking your child into the building you must park in a parking spot and use the sidewalk to access the building.
- Park east of the canopy and use the sidewalk alongside the church for all drop-off and pick-ups if you are not using the car line.
- For safety reasons, do not walk in front of the cars in the car line.



- Pull your car as far forward as possible when picking up or dropping off your child using the car line.

- Students are not permitted to be picked up using the stairs off of 16th Avenue because there is no adult supervision in that area.
- Please be respectful to the busses in the morning by adhering to the stop sign laws and do not go around a parked bus with the sign out.



## **Qualifying Incomes**

- Family Size 2 \$38,324

To calculate the income of married families - take the total family income and subtract \$7,000, then compare that to the chart above. Example: If a family of 4 with parents that are married has an income of \$60,000, subtract \$7,000 and compare that amount (\$53,000) to the income limit for a family of four in the table above.
