DROP OFF & PICK UP REMINDERS (For everyone's safety and sanity.)

- Children in car seats can <u>ONLY</u> be dropped off or picked up using the car line option if you <u>PULL UP</u> to the far side of the car line <u>alongside the cones near</u> <u>the basketball hoops</u>. This way you are not blocking all of the cars behind you from getting out as you remove your child from their car seat.
- <u>DO NOT</u> walk through or in front of the car line to drop off or pick up your child. Anyone using sidewalk drop off/pick up <u>MUST</u> park on the <u>FAR EAST SIDE</u> of the parking lot and walk along the sidewalk <u>in front of the</u> <u>church</u> to drop off or pick up their child. This protects all of our children and families.

VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES

Drop-Off & Pick-Up

We look forward to seeing you on the first day of school. Here is a reminder of our drop-off and pick-up procedure.

- 1. Bus Students taking the bus will be dropped off between 8:00 & 8:15. After school, they will be supervised in the bus line located by the elementary wing doors.
- 2. Car Line Parents may use the car pick-up line to stay in their car and drop off and pick up their child along the cones. Please <u>do not</u> park under the canopy. *This is the preferred method in the morning, as it makes it much easier on the little ones who sometimes have a hard time letting go.
- 3. Sidewalk Parents may park in the parking spaces on the <u>east side</u> of the parking lot and walk along the sidewalk by the church to drop off or gather their child by the playground. For the safety of everyone, do not walk in front of or between the cars in the pick-up line. Please remember, students are not allowed to play on the playground after school unless they are supervised by their parent/guardian.
- 4. Middle School Only Option New this year, Middle School Students may walk to the far end of the sidewalk past the church and meet their parent/guardian at their parked car in one of the designated parking spots on the far east side of the parking lot. This applies only to Middle School Students who do not have a younger sibling.

Uniform Dress Code Reminder

Before purchasing new uniforms for your children please review our uniform policy below.

A couple of things to remember:

- Shorts may be worn in August, September, October, May and June
- All leggings must be a solid color Fire Engine Red, Navy Blue, White, Grey, or Black
- Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in
- Shorts, jumpers, and skirts must be of reasonable length (3" above the knee)
- Jumpers must have large plaid squares or be solid navy or brown khaki only
- Shorts or leggings must be worn under skirts or jumpers
- Shoes must have a back strap and socks must be worn
