WEEKLY CLASSROOM HIGHLIGHTS

Welcome back! It has been such a delight to see the students back in the building and ready to take on another year at SJPS - I know it is going to be a great one. In order to start off on the right foot, the 6th, 7th and 8th graders played a rousing game of Grudgeball to refresh their memories regarding school rules and expectations. This is always a fun game because teams are able to keep their points or take away from opponents (which they enjoy quite a bit)! Then, to get the ball rolling and not waste any time, the middle schoolers jumped right into their first unit, Scientific Inquiry. We started this unit with a lab where students were tasked with rolling dice and trying to determine the rules to figure out how many polar bears and fish were present on the five dice. Using a poem and visual clues on the board, students needed to collaborate with their lab partners, make connections between the organisms and infer the outcome of each sequence. It was a difficult, but the students were up for the task and successfully came to a conclusion as to the rules of the game. I look forward to challenging the middle school students throughout the year and to see what they can do!









Educator Tips for Parents for a Successful School Year

- 1. **Be Enthusiastic** You set the tone. The more positive you are about your child's classmates, classroom activities, homework, school policies, and teachers, the more likely your child will have a positive attitude and show enthusiasm for school, even when it is hard.
- 2. Communicate with your Child's Teacher The more they know the more they can help your child learn and grow. Tell your child's teacher everything and don't be afraid to contact them regarding their social-emotional wellbeing and academic progress.
- 3. Establish Consistent Morning, Homework, Meal, and Bedtime Routines Children thrive on boundaries, structure and consistency.
- 4. **Get Involved** Ask your child about their day and what they are learning about. Be specific in your questioning and willing to learn alongside them. Participate in your child's education and volunteer whenever possible.
- 5. Read! Read! Read with and around your child, and

- model and encourage reading over playing video games or watching television.
- 6. **Give Yourself Grace** Parenting is hard! Understand your child's teacher and school are here to partner with you to help your child learn and thrive.
