WEEKLY CLASSROOM HIGHLIGHT By Julie Dich 5th-Grade Teacher

This week the 4^{th} and 5^{th} graders did a team building retreat with the theme of, "Love thy Neighbor." Together we read 1 John 4:2 and then reflected on what it means to love your neighbor. We talked about what makes it difficult sometimes and what we can do to try to always show love and compassion to others. After a quick ice breaker activity called, "Find Your Group," the students, who were now divided into groups of 3 or 4, worked together for a STEM/Collaborative activity. The students were given 6 cups, 4 pipe cleaners, and 1 rubber band. They were told they could not touch the cups at all and they had to construct a device that would be able to move the cups to form various towers. It took a bit for some of the groups to be successful, but they all got there eventually! As a closure, the students completed a reflection sheet where they explained what went well, what didn't, and how it felt working together to solve a problem. There certainly were a lot of smiles during this activity and a great deal of positive collaboration!






CALLING ALL FISH FRY ENTHUSIASTS!
