The third graders have been very busy so far this year. We have been fortunate enough to go on two field trips already. Our first was to Bookworm Gardens in Sheboygan for an afternoon of exploring beautiful gardens all inspired by some wonderful children's books. We also got to head to Holy Hill to experience Mass, praying the Rosary and walking the outdoor Stations of the Cross.

Back at school, the third graders have been busy learning all about multiplication! This is a major part of the third grade math curriculum. Soon they will begin Math Minutes to work on speed and accuracy with all those facts! They are exploring the Mystery Science unit, Power of Flowers, and have explored a variety of things including how bees pollinate flowers and what makes something a science fruit or science vegetable. In social studies they are reviewing map skills and beginning to explore the five regions of the US. They are also sharpening their comprehension skills by reading a variety of stories to prepare for diving into novels soon.

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
