

WEEKLY CLASSROOM HIGHLIGHT By Julie Lemke, 2nd Grade Teacher

On Halloween, the 1st, 2nd and 3rd graders participated in a team-building retreat with the theme of, "The Holy Trinity." Together we watched this video: https://youtu.be/oK5y_KMm2FUread and then discussed what we learned about The Trinity as being three in one. Next, we listened to passages from scripture to see if we could identify if the passage was about the Father, Son, or Holy Spirit. After that, the classes were split into mixed-grade groups of three, with one first grader, one second grader and one third grader. In their groups, they were given the challenge to work as *three in one* to create the tallest candy corn tower that could stand on its own, using only candy corn and toothpicks. Candy corn was used as a representation of The Holy Trinity, another example of *three in one*. At the end of 15 minutes, all towers were measured to see which one was the tallest. The tallest tower was 6 and ½ inches! As a closure to the activity, the students reflected on what went well working together and what was most challenging. The final wrap up activity was to use watercolor paint to make a candy corn representation of The Holy Trinity. This was a great way to spend our afternoon on Halloween!


