

WEEKLY CLASSROOM HIGHLIGHTS

The kindergarten class is learning about living and non-living things. We began the new unit activating our schema by drawing upon our experiences to make a list of what living things need to survive. Following this activity, the class charted the

differences between living and non-living things. Students then completed a living/non-living picture sort. This served as a great tool to see how students understand the differences. As they grouped the images, the students had to justify why they put each image where they did.

The class went on a living and non-living scavenger hunt outside following our work in the classroom. Students made their own lists of living and non-living things. Once we returned to the classroom, each student shared his or her list and explained why classified items were found in their respective places. For the culminating activity, we used our learning to compare and contrast a living and non-living thing: WORMS! We used gummy worms and earthworms! Making this comparison was fun for students, and they had a sense of accomplishment and demonstrated to each other a shared delight in learning.


Grab-and-Go Weekend Meal Program
