WEEKLY CLASSROOM HIGHLIGHTS By Ms. Longoria K4 Teacher

One of our favorite K4 units so far this school year was creating a Teddy Bear Hospital. We gathered supplies and created our hospital space. As we opened for business each child brought in their "patients" and went to work. The students had to fill out admitting paperwork for each of their bears and then they took on the various hospital staff roles. There were a lot of caring doctors and nurses, surgeries, and ambulance rides.

Engaging in dramatic play is an important learning experience for young children and has many benefits. It teaches self-control as students make plans and work with others, promotes expressive language, encourages thinking skills, and boost problem solving skills. As the students "play" they are learning how to take turns, share responsibility, and develop empathy. The students are also seeing "functional print" in action as they use check lists, labels, and signs.

Our hospital had many patients with broken bones, stomach aches, and mystery aliments. At the end of each patient's stay, the K4 kids completed a treatment plan for their bears and all the bears went home feeling better!




