All order forms and payment are due back to school by Friday, September 29th. Cash or checks made payable to SJPS.



Weekly Classroom Highlights By: Mr. Kempf, MS ELA Teacher

It's the "Write" Time in Middle School!

The 6th grade class has started doing many pre-writing activities for the personal narratives they'll be writing. This journey will continue next week as they bring items that hold meaning from their homes. They will eventually select one piece of writing to focus on and polish up for their final draft. They won't have to go it alone though, as we'll also be working on the skills of providing constructive feedback to our peers. I am hoping they'll start to see a difference between making revisions and editing their written work.

In 7th grade we are exploring what makes a good memoir and how it is different from a personal narrative. To help us along the way, we've been reading, examining and

exploring memoirs written by professional writers. Looking closely at their craft and how we can emulate what they've done. Next week, to really get our brains going, we'll be working on creating 6 word memoirs, which we will then expand to longer written pieces.

The 8th graders have begun the challenging task of putting together an autobiography. We've begun by doing a lot of brainstorming to help us think about our pasts, which we'll continue to do going into next week before we even consider starting the writing process. As we continue our journey we have been and will continue to examine other published autobiographies. Not only are the 8th graders reading an autobiography of their choice, but we are also studying selected excerpts from published autobiographies to help us learn the craft.




Come Join Our St. Joseph Parish School Children's Choir!
