Weekly Classroom Highlight Ms. Myers, 4th Grade Teacher

A favorite 4th grade activity is called "Tune Tuesday." Each Tuesday, we listen to a song and closely read the lyrics. The class then determines what the song is about, and finds the theme (or message) of the song and supports this with textual evidence from the lyrics. We also use the lyrics to find examples of figurative language, and make text-to-text or text-to-self connections. As the year goes on and the class's skill set expands, we use the song lyrics to determine point-of-view as well.

This week, we listened to the song "Unwritten" by Natasha Bedingfield. The class loved this song, and everyone sang along with the inspirational lyrics. We then engaged in some animated discussions about what the lyrics mean and what the song is mostly about. The class then determined that this song uses the analogy of an unwritten book to describe our lives, and that the message is that

we should chase our dreams and take risks.


