Weekly Classroom Highlight By: Sra. Hayes, Spanish Teacher

iFeliz Año Nuevo!

How is it already 2024?? I feel like it was just yesterday day when we were making Flor de Nochebuena (Poinsettia) ornaments with buddy classes during Advent! We finished the year making Spanish Christmas cards for a school in the Dominican Republic. We have some really talented kids at St. Joseph's!

The classes started off the year learning about Los Tres Reyes

Magos (Three Kings Day) and the similarities and differences between the places that celebrate this 12th day of Navidad. 4th grade and under classes are reviewing their numbers up to 100 and some classes are learning up to 1,000. Most will be doing some sort of vocabulary with Dia de San Valentín very soon.

7th grade is working on a unit to use the verbs Estar and Ir to talk about communities and places and where they are and where they are going. They are just finishing up a poster of these places and they will be hanging in the hallway soon! 5th and 6th grade are working on classroom objects and prepositions of place and will soon be completing this unit. 8th grade has begun the food unit, or what I like to call everyone's favorite Spanish unit. 8thgraders will be doing many different things this year including a classroom dictionary display along with cooking a meal at home and recording it for the class to watch.

This spring I am going to do an exploratory class for both of our K3 classes and K4. They will probably come home singing Spanish songs. Learning Spanish is so much fun!
