Weekly Classroom Highlights By: Melissa Myers, 4th Grade Teacher

In Science, 4th grade is learning all about sound. In this lesson, titled "How Far Can a Whisper Travel?" the class learned that sound is caused by vibrations. To learn more about how sound moves from one place to another, we made old-fashioned, paper cup telephones. Students had an opportunity to first test out their cups on their own; speaking into them to feel the vibrations on the cup with their hands, and plucking or stroking the string to see if they could hear it through the cup. Finally, students tied their strings together and passed secret numbers to each other. Next, they tested out their cups by tying more than two together to send messages, or by stretching their strings around a corner to see if their telephones still work. This lesson is part of a larger unity called "Seeing Sound." By the end of the unit, students will make their own machines that will actually show sound!




