



# Weekly Classroom Highlights By Amanda Christian, K3 Teacher

The students in our all-day K3 program have been actively engaged in learning and have grown so much. This week, they were particularly enthusiastic about learning about the eclipse. They took part in making moon and sun puppets to demonstrate how the moon moves in front of the sun, explored pictures of the earth, moon, and sun taken by astronauts and other important scientists, and practiced eye safety when looking at the sun.

While the eclipse unit has been a source of fun, our primary focus throughout the year has been on phonological awareness. This foundational skill is crucial for early reading development. Many of our activities are designed to be oral lessons, allowing the children to truly grasp the sounds that each letter makes. By strengthening their phonics base, we are setting these children up for future success as confident and proficient readers.

Additionally, we have had so much fun with various dress-up days, field trips, Catholic Schools Week, and so much more. Up next, the K3 students will learn what it means to be a superhero.
