## **EARLY CHILDHOOD ROUND UP** Friday, August 23rd & Monday, August 26th

Calling all K3, K4, and K5 Students and Families!

In the next couple of days, your child's teacher will reach out with a link for you to schedule your Early Childhood Round Up meeting day/time.

This parent/child/teacher meeting allows our teachers to get to know your child and your family. Your child will also be able to check out the classroom to alleviate any beginning of the year jitters.

## Drop-Off & Pick-Up

We look forward to seeing you on the first day of school. Here is a reminder of our drop-off and pick-up procedure.

- 1. Bus Students taking the bus will be dropped off between 8:00 & 8:15. After school, they will be supervised in the bus line located by the elementary wing doors.
- 2. Car Line Parents may use the car pick-up line to stay in their car and drop off and pick up their child along the cones. Please <u>do not</u> park under the canopy. \*This is the preferred method in the morning, as it makes it much easier on the little ones who sometimes have a hard time letting go. Parents of children requiring a carseat must pull their car all the way up to the cones closest to the basketball hoops if they need get out of the car to buckle or unbuckle their child.
- 3. Sidewalk Parents may park in the parking spaces on the <u>east side</u> of the parking lot and <u>walk along the sidewalk by</u> <u>the church</u> to drop off or gather their child by the playground. For the safety of everyone, do not walk in front of or between the cars in the pick-up line.
- 4. Middle School Only Option Middle School Students may walk to the far end of the sidewalk past the church and meet their parent/guardian at their parked car in one of the designated parking spots on the far east side of the parking lot. This applies only to Middle School Students who do not have a younger sibling.

Please remember, students are not allowed to play on the playground after school unless they are supervised by their parent/guardian.

## **Uniform Dress Code Reminder**



Before purchasing new uniforms for your children please review

our uniform policy below.

A couple of things to remember:

- Shorts may be worn in August, September, October, May and June
- All leggings must be a solid color Fire Engine Red, Navy Blue, White, Grey, or Black
- Shirts must be long enough to be tucked in
- Shorts, jumpers, and skirts must be of reasonable length (3" above the knee)
- Jumpers and skirts must have large plaid squares or be solid navy or brown khaki only
- Shorts or leggings must be worn under skirts or jumpers
- Shoes must have a back strap and socks must be worn
