Weekly Classroom Highlights

Middle school ELA has gotten off to a great start this year. Since the beginning of the year, each grade level has defined and explored the theme we'll be focusing on this year. 6th grade is exploring the theme of family, 7th grade is exploring courage and 8th grade is exploring adversity. We'll be examining how each of these themes are represented in the novels that we read throughout the year. To assist with our exploration, we'll be reading and watching many different types of media that relate directly to the novels that we are reading to help aid in our understanding of the novel and the theme we're exploring.

Each group has also begun to examine their first writing project which will be a

narrative. They are currently reading through and looking closely at mentor texts of the type of writing they will be doing. That means that the 6th graders are reading personal narratives to determine writing skills they can use in their own narratives. Similarly 7th grade is reading through some memoir examples and comparing those to personal narratives to determine the differences so that their memoirs don't become personal narratives. Finally, 8th grader's first reading assignment was to select and begin reading an autobiography as we'll be working on writing our own abbreviated autobiographies.

It's a very exciting time in middle school ELA and the students here at SJPS make teaching an even more rewarding experience.
