



Pertusssis (Whooping Cough)

The Washington/Ozaukee Health Department has indicated that there has been a recent rise in respiratory illnesses, specifically pertussis (whooping cough). As we navigate this situation, it's essential to stay vigilant for symptoms and to practice good hygiene, including regular hand washing and keeping children home from school when they feel unwell.

What is pertussis? (Whooping Cough)

Pertussis (Whooping Cough) is a contagious bacterial illness that affects the respiratory tract. It is spread by exposure to respiratory droplets from an infected person through coughing.

What are the symptoms of pertussis?

Early symptoms can appear similar to the flu such as:

- Runny nose or sneezing
- Occasional or mild cough
- Low grade fever

Later symptoms include:

- Persistent cough
- Coughing fits which make it difficult to breathe or cause vomiting

How soon do symptoms appear?

Symptoms usually appear between 7-10 days after exposure, with a range of 5-21 days. If your child shows symptoms above, the Ozaukee Health Department is recommending that you contact your health care provider to schedule a visit.

Weekly Classroom Highlights By. Mrs. O'Dell, Reading Interventionist

There is so much happening in Reading/ English Language Arts at St. Joseph Parish School this year. All students in grades 1-3 have been put together and regrouped for a short, fun burst of Phonemic Awareness each morning. Phonemic Awareness is a foundational skill for reading. By assigning groups based on skill level, students are receiving instruction where they need. The groups are very flexible and change often.

In Grades 1-5, there are dedicated, uninterrupted 90-minute Reading/ English Language Art Blocks. The students experience whole group reading lessons, small group reading lessons, writing, spelling and phonics. This uninterrupted block allows the students and the teachers to focus on Reading and associated skills for a prolonged time.

St. Joseph Parish School is embarking on selecting a new Reading Curriculum this year. We are at the very beginning of this exciting journey. We will be reviewing and piloting curriculum that will best fit our needs and our Catholic identity.
