

# **Weekly Classroom Highlights**

Greetings from the Gym at St Joseph Parish School! This fall in all the grade levels we've been working on lots of skills for dodgeball games. This includes running, throwing, catching, blocking, dodging, teamwork, and sportsmanship. In the lower grades we've done variations on Warball and Castleball, which involve less "targeting" of other students, and more of trying to knock things down (pins, pickle balls on cones, castles made of hula hoops). This style game keeps all students engaged in the activity, instead of being "out" when they get hit.

In the upper grades, along with Warball and Castleball, we've tried some other variations that allow for smaller teams to coordinate, using only four dodgeballs. We've also done larger, more chaotic games of Swampball/Prisionball and Medic Dodgeball.

Sometimes folks get pretty competitive in these sorts of games; when tempers run hot, we take the opportunity to COMMUNICATE, to ensure our actions are for the good of the team, that they are showing good sportsmanship, and that we aren't getting too bent out of shape over a game. We end each gym class finding a competitor to give them a high five or a fist bump, and to tell them "good game."


