Weekly Classroom Highlights



The K5 through Eighth grade students at St. Joseph Parish School were

recently administered the mid-year I-Ready Diagnostic Assessment. The St. Joseph Parish School students made tremendous gains from the beginning of the year diagnostic until now. All students in K5 through Eighth Grade were assessed. In the area of reading, 75% of the students achieved at or above grade level. This is an increase from the beginning of the year when 56% of students were reading at or above grade level. In math, on the beginning of the year diagnostic, 39% of students were achieving at or above grade level. That has increased to 63%.

Other highlights include 94% of K5-2 grade students are achieving at or above grade level in the area of Phonemic Awareness, with two grades achieving 100%. This is an increase from 73% at the beginning of the year. 93% of all students assessed achieved a rating of at or above grade level in Phonics, this is an increase from 81% on the beginning of the year diagnostic.

Congratulations to all the students and teachers for their hard work!
