### Weekly Classroom Highlights By Miss Jackson, 3rd Grade Teacher

The SJPS Third Grade class has been working very hard! After spending the last few months of school learning all about multiplication and division, they are now applying their new skills to determine the perimeter and area of basic rectangles and figures composed of multiple rectangles by decomposing them. They are also mastering their multiplication and division facts within 100 so they are well prepared to move on to higher

level learning including all about fractions and different types of measurement.

In reading, the third graders continue to participate in small reading groups working at their own personal levels, while also reading the novel, Stone Fox as a whole class. Once we finish reading the novel, they will write another opinion piece about who they believe the hero of the story to be. This is a great integration of all areas of Reading and Language Arts. We continue to learn more about heredity, survival and selection while completing hands-on Mystery Science activities in our Fates of Traits unit, and we are exploring how things both stay the same and change over time in the context of historical events in social studies.

Finally, the third graders have learned about the four marks of the Catholic Church, the many ministries within the church, the four types of prayer and will be embarking on an exploration of the Seven Sacraments. They also continue to enjoy hearing Father Tim's homilies each week during our school Masses on Thursdays.
