I would like to take a moment to express how incredibly proud I am of our first graders. Each day, they arrive at school with eagerness to learn, grow, and support one another. In math, our students have been working on essential concepts, thinking critically, and explaining their reasoning in new ways. They are developing effective problem-solving skills and learning new strategies along the way. In reading, their fluency and comprehension continue to improve, and they are building strong foundational skills. They are also becoming more thoughtful writers, carefully using our writing checklist to express their ideas in complete sentences.

Beyond academics, our first graders are also developing into kind, respectful, and responsible individuals. They consistently encourage one another, practice empathy, and are learning the importance of collaboration and teamwork. Their curiosity and excitement make our classroom a warm and inspiring place to be.

One of the special milestones we recently celebrated was our 100th day of school. To mark the occasion, Miss Johnson created t-shirts for the class that read, "I survived 100 days of school." Each student had the opportunity to count out 100 band-aids and decorate their shirts, with designs ranging from fun images to their names. It was a joyful celebration, and these shirts will serve as cherished keepsakes for years to come—although, they may not fit! 

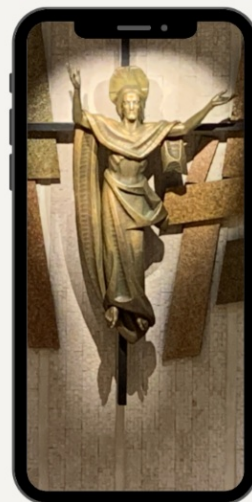
