


Weekly Classroom Highlights

Recently, the fifth graders have been learning all about earthworms and the important role they play when decomposing dead material and releasing nutrients into the soil. The students then did a Mystery Science activity where they first observed the behavior of earthworms when placed on a wet paper towel and a small piece of black paper. The worms either crawled under the black paper or the wet paper towel. This is because earthworms like to burrow under things and avoid light. The second part of the experiment was to see if worms prefer dry or wet areas by placing their worm on a paper towel that was half wet and half dry. Sure enough, the worms all preferred the wet paper towel. Finally, we all put the earthworms from our experiment in our plant that we have growing by the window. It was cool to see them all wiggly on the top of the dirt in the pot at first and then bury themselves under the top layer of soil. We will see if the plant starts to grow better now that it has worms in it!


