#### A Message from Fr. Tim

Dear Parents.

One of the hallmarks of Catholic education is the recognition of the primary role parents take in the education of their children. At SJPS, we are humbled by the trust you place in us to share in this awesome responsibility.

I'm very grateful for Amanda Matthews' leadership. She was instrumental in bringing together our incredible faculty and staff, the parish community, and you, the school families, to collectively build SJPS into a premier Catholic school. During my first year at St. Joseph, I knew our school was something special for our parish. Over the last six weeks as I have met and worked closely with our teachers, I am even more convinced that we have a great faculty who remain committed to building and growing on the foundation that has been established. Our school's foundation is strong, rooted in Christ, and under their guidance, will continue to be a gift to our parish and community.

We have made a decision about the upcoming school year after discerning multiple options. In collaboration with the Archdiocese, parish leadership, and members of the school leadership team, we have discerned that our best option is to move forward with an interim solution.

With a dedicated and veteran teaching staff, faithful families, a tight-knit community, and a strong

parish family, we are uniquely positioned to take an interim approach and we believe it will best serve our school, its students, families, and teachers. This interim approach will ensure we have access to more qualified candidates during the peak hiring season for principals. We will reinitiate our search in early 2026 to identify the candidate who will join all of us in being the hands of Christ, open to all.

The interim solution will involve a combination of multiple teachers stepping into roles of increased responsibility and the addition of some external resources who have deep roots in administration and Catholic Education. Chris Jackson, Julie Lemke, and Carren Gratz graciously agreed to step into interim administrative roles and will collaborate with me, the school's leadership team, Lisa Jauron in the parish business office, and the Archdiocese to ensure a successful year. These three leaders will share the administrative responsibilities, each according to their many talents. We are actively pursuing one additional member for this team, an experienced Catholic school administrator, who will provide them with guidance, hands-on support, and the occasional extra set of hands in the office, while ensuring our faculty will be fully present to your children in the classroom.

As this team navigates their new areas of responsibility, we will reach out to other dedicated members of our staff, parents, and the parish community to invite participation and support in making this year a resounding success. I invite you to discern your own gifts and talents and where God is calling you to give of your time and talent to build on the strong foundation at SJPS. Please respond generously to the Lord's call this year — I have it on good authority He often uses Sign-up Genius, the Lancer Times, and notes in backpacks when He's calling for your help!

Thank you for your patience as we worked through our discernment process. I recognize that times of uncertainty can be difficult and I appreciate you trusting us in making these decisions. I want to continue hearing from you with any questions, comments, or concerns. Please join me in continued prayers for our school, our teachers, and our school families. As St. Joseph protected Jesus, we ask for his intercession and protection of our school as we embark on the 2025-2026 school year.


#### **IMPORTANT - Early Childhood Roundup!**
