~ A Note from the Leadership Team ~

Dear St Joseph Parish School Families,

We have two important things to share with you today. First we want to share that we have two very friendly and familiar faces managing the school office while we begin the process of hiring a new administrative

assistant for the school. We are thrilled to welcome back Mrs. Sue Henke and Mrs. Becky Meyer! They both have many years of experience not only with St. Joseph Parish School, but also with the inner workings of the school office. Please welcome them if you see them around and thank them for their continued commitment and support of SJPS.

In following up to last week's Safety and Security letter, we want to reiterate that SJPS is firmly committed to providing a secure environment where children can learn, grow, and flourish in faith and in knowledge. While we continue to pray for peace and healing, we wanted to update SJPS families on the action steps taken in order to maintain the highest level of safety for students, staff and community members during school Masses.

Last week, the Leadership team met with Fr. Tim to address concerns and identify solutions to

continue to further enhance safety and security measures during school Masses. We also consulted with members of the school and parish Safety and Security team to find viable options that meet the needs of all those who wish to attend mass or have business to conduct with the school or parish.

In response to the concerns, we tested out and have decided to take the following actions to maintain a commitment to ensuring every child feels safe during our Thursday school Masses:

- By 8:35am, the church doors will be locked for the duration of Mass.
- A member of the Safety and Security team will be posted at the church doors to let in community members who wish to attend mass, but arrive late or have business to take care of in the parish office.
- A Grafton Police Department patrol vehicle will be stationed in the parking lot as often as they are able to, assuming there is not a pressing issue in the community that they are needed at.
- A uniformed GPD officer will attend mass, as often as they are able to. We were thrilled to see Officer Alfonsi in the Gathering Space today.

We will continue to meet and discuss the efficiency and practicality of all safety and security measures on a regular basis and communicate pertinent information as it arises with SJPS families. If you continue to have any concerns or wish to learn more about our safety practices, we encourage you to reach out to us directly at principal@stjosephgrafton.org. SAFE ENVIRONMENT TRAINING

Drop-Off & Pick-Up

We look forward to seeing you on the first day of school. Here is a reminder of our drop-off and pick-up procedure.

- 1. Bus Students taking the bus will be dropped off between 8:00 & 8:15. After school, they will be supervised in the bus line located by the elementary wing doors.
- 2. Car Line Parents may use the car pick-up line to stay in their car and drop off and pick up their child along the cones. Please do not park under the canopy. *This is the preferred method in the morning, as it makes it much easier on the little ones who sometimes have a hard time letting go. Parents of children requiring a carseat must pull their car all the way up to the cones closest to the basketball hoops if they need get out of the car to buckle or unbuckle their child.
- 3. Sidewalk Parents may park in the parking spaces on the <u>east side</u> of the parking lot and <u>walk along the sidewalk</u> <u>by the church</u> to drop off or gather their child by the playground. For the safety of everyone, do not walk in front of or between the cars in the pick-up line.
- 4. Middle School Only Option Middle School Students may walk to the far end of the sidewalk past the church and meet their parent/guardian at their parked car in one of the designated parking spots on the far east side of the parking lot. This applies only to Middle School Students who do not have a younger sibling.

Please remember, students are not allowed to play on the playground after school unless they are supervised by their parent/guardian.




RAISERIGHT TUITION CREDIT OPPORTUNITY

What is Student of the Month?

The SJPS staff is so proud of our students and would like to recognize those who go above and beyond. The faculty and staff will celebrate our incredible students this year through the *Student of the Month Program* Each month, one nominee will be chosen from each level: Early Childhood (K3-K5), Elementary (1st grade - 4th grade), and Middle School (5th grade - 8th grade). When the students are chosen, they will receive a sign to put in their yard, be announced on the morning announcements, have their picture in the Lancer Times, and hung on a bulletin board near the school office, and receive a Student of the Month

☐ September Character Trait: KINDNESS

What It Means:

Kindness is showing care, compassion, and respect toward others through words and actions. It means being helpful, inclusive, and thoughtful—without expecting anything in return.

How Students Demonstrate Kindness:

- Greeting classmates and staff with a smile or kind words
- Helping a peer without being asked (e.g., picking up dropped items, explaining directions)
- Including others in group activities or play
- Complimenting others sincerely
- Listening when others are speaking and showing empathy
- Using polite language consistently (please, thank you, excuse me)
- Standing up for someone who is being left out or treated unfairly
- Showing appreciation to teachers, peers, and staff

How Parents Can Support at Home:

- Talk about what kindness looks like in everyday life
- Encourage children to share kind acts from their day
- Read books or watch shows that promote empathy and compassion
- · Model kind behavior in your own interactions

Weekly Classroom Highlights

And so it begins! I am very excited to be welcoming students back to our SJPS middle school for another year! Day one of this academic year had the middle school students already completing a variety of activities that put them to work and challenged their abilities to work together.

What I tell all the students on the first day (and almost daily after that) is that the name of the game in my classroom is COLLABORATION. Students are

regularly put into small group or partner activities and are expected to work to understand how to properly complete a task within a group setting. They are tasked with delegating roles, taking responsibility/ownership of certain tasks, engaging in respectful discourse and working as an effective teammate.

To kick off this year, students worked in small groups on a Polar Bear Inquiry activity that challenged their critical thinking skills. They were given minimal information on polar bear hunting tactics and fish migration. From there, they were asked to roll a dice and I dictated how many fish and/or bears they had with the ultimate goal of working together to determine the rules of the game. This required them to analyze the data in front of them, apply critical thinking skills, think outside the box and make inferences from information already presented. It was not an easy task, but most groups were successful in identifying the rules!


