Weekly Classroom Highlights


Last week, 3rd and 4th grades met for a retreat around the theme of "Love Thy Neighbor." The students had a discussion about what it means to love your neighbor, as well as the Great Commandment and the Golden Rule. We discussed ways to include others and treat each other with kindness.

The students then engaged in an activity called Find Your Group, in which each student was given a label on their back naming them some part of a trio; ketchup, mustard and hot dog; marshmallow, graham cracker and Hershey bar; etc. They could only ask yes or no questions, requiring them to use critical thinking skills while collaborating with their peers. After finding their group, 1st and 2nd grades joined us for a STEM activity.

Mixed groups were tasked with building the tallest tower out of marshmallows and toothpicks. They only had 12 minutes to complete this task. Throughout the activity, students had to collaborate, assign tasks, and ensure everyone in the group had a say. At the end of this activity, students learned that working with others goes best when we listen to each other, use kind words when we disagree, and treat each other with respect and dignity.

How Students Demonstrate Responsibility:

- · Turning in assignments and homework on time
- Bringing necessary materials to class
- · Following rules and instructions without reminders
- · Admitting mistakes and working to fix them
- Helping keep shared spaces clean and organized
- Managing time well (e.g., balancing school and play)
- Taking care of personal belongings and school supplies
- · Following through on promises or tasks given

How Parents Can Support at Home:

- · Give children age-appropriate tasks and chores to build accountability
- Set clear expectations and follow through with routines
- · Praise efforts to be responsible, not just results
- · Encourage children to solve small problems on their own
- Talk about choices and consequences in real-life situations
- Be a role model—show responsibility in your words and actions




Help Keep Our Community Warm!
