school counselor, Amber Harrigan who comes to us from a local organization, Harrigan Counseling Services. Miss Amber brings a wealth of experience in supporting students' academic, social, and emotional growth from her time in school districts throughout the county. She is passionate about helping children succeed, building strong relationships with families, and creating a positive and caring school environment. She will be working with our students all day on Mondays and Friday mornings. She will be seeing students individually, in small groups, and conducting all group lessons in the classrooms. Her official start date will be announced once her Safe Environment Training has been completed.

We are also working with the School Counseling Graduate Program at Mount Mary to place a graduate student in counseling with us as well. More details to follow in the next month or so. 


