A Message from the SJPS
School Advisory Committee

December 5, 2025

To our St. Joseph Parish School Parent Community,

As members of the School Advisory Committee, as well as parents of students in our school, one of our highest priorities is safety. That's why we are taking on an issue that's affecting our entire community: the drop-off/pick-up lines. I know we have all experienced frustration with various aspects of the current configuration; there is a reason this is a cliché problem area for so many schools! However, I know we can also agree that we all care more deeply about the safety and wellbeing of our children and staff than our small, impatient annoyances.

In light of the issues we've been having, and following the recommended guidelines of other local area elementary schools, we are moving forward with some changes to the drop-off/pick-up lines.

Firstly, as a reminder, please see the attached diagram for the **correct way to enter and exit the parking lot**. Entrance Only occurs from 17th Avenue. Exit Only occurs from Bridge Street. These are the only acceptable uses for these spaces during the drop-off/pick-up periods.

Secondly, **adults that want or need to exit their cars to help with buckling, give hugs, need extra time, or for any reason at all are always welcome to do so, by parking in the East side of the parking lot**, separate from the drop-off/pick-up line (marked on the map in pink, as park here). If you choose this option, please walk your child to the sidewalk and under the overhang, keeping clear of the drop-off/pick-up line (see attached diagram). In contrast, for the safety of all, **adults using then drop-off/pick-up line are not allowed to exit their cars**. Children in the drop-off/pick-up lines should exit and enter the vehicle from the passenger side. **NO ONE should walk through the drop-off/pick-up line for any reason at any time.**

Thirdly, during pick-up, **teachers will release students by total family to get into their cars**. Please remember that school does not officially end until 3:15, and it should be parents' expectation that students won't be released prior to this time.

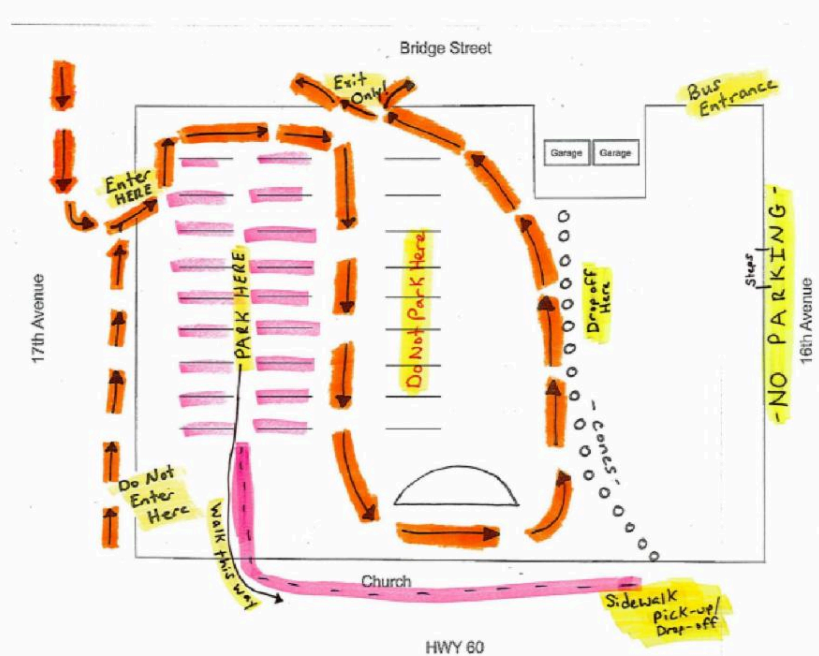
Again, safety is our number one priority, and the procedures outlined are to ensure a safe start and end to each and every school day. **Please share this with any additional family members participating in the drop-off or pick-up processes**. If you have any questions regarding these procedures, please don't hesitate to reach out to any member of the School Advisory Committee.

For safety purposes, please only **ENTER** the parking lot from the **17th Avenue** driveway and **EXIT** only onto **Bridge St** during morning drop-off between **8:00 - 8:15am** and during afternoon pick-up between **3:00 - 3:20pm**.
