



# St. Joseph Parish School Special Needs Scholarship Program

The Special Needs Scholarship Program (SNSP) allows a student with a disability, who meets certain eligibility requirements, to receive a state-funded scholarship to attend St. Joseph Parish School. SNSP applications can be submitted to SNSP schools for each school year from July 1st to June 30<sup>th</sup>. A student who receives an SNSP scholarship will continue to receive that scholarship as long as they remain enrolled at St. Joseph Parish School, continue with an IEP or service plan, and reside in the state of Wisconsin.

## WHO CAN APPLY?

- A student who has an Individualized Education Plan (IEP) or an Individualized Services Plan (ISP)
- A student who resides in the state of Wisconsin
- Student must meet the following age requirements on or before September 1st:
  - 4 years old to enter K4
  - 5 years old to enter K5
  - 6 years old to enter grade 1

**Open Enrollment for 2026-2027 runs July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026 through June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2027.**

All required information must be submitted on your application, or it will be deemed ineligible. Residency documentation must be submitted with the application to consider it complete. Applying earlier will improve your chances of obtaining a seat.

SNSP schools are required to accept SNSP students in the order that complete applications and transfer requests are received. Schools may choose to give preference to siblings of students who are already attending the school. If SJPS receives more eligible applications than the number of available SNSP scholarships, SJPS will notify students of their place on the SNSP waiting list within three weeks.
